Instructions for Using Product	
Description of Use(s)	To hold one box or three boxes of gloves to be placed in all patient care areas.
Preparation for Use	Remove the dispenser from packaging.
	2. Securely mount to the wall by inserting the screws into the wall.
	3. Place the dispenser onto the screws at the bottom.
	4. Then place the dispenser with the two screw holders that are located on the
	back of the dispenser onto the screws to hold the dispenser in place.

Steps for Use of Product	 Pull the perforated tab off of the box(es) of gloves. From the top of the dispenser, slide glove box down into the dispenser with the opening of the box facing forward. For the triple box dispenser, slide a glove box down into each of the dividers with the opening of the box facing forward. Pull gloves out of the box one at a time. Dispose of after single use.
